

Supporting Farnham Sinfonia

The ethos of Farnham Sinfonia is to programme symphonies of Haydn and Mozart on modern instruments which seldom enter the current concert repertoire in combination with some 20th century British and contemporary composers whose works are still undervalued or insufficiently known.

After two successful concerts demonstrating the capabilities of the Sinfonia, we need to look for funding to establish the Sinfonia more permanently as the ticket sales cover only about half the low fees paid to the professional performers.

Tilford Bach Society (CIO) has offered to allow Farnham Sinfonia to operate under its umbrella sharing its charitable status but maintaining a separate website and identity.

So we are now seeking people and organisations to become sponsors of the Sinfonia and to sign a pledge that will take effect only if we receive sufficient sponsorship to establish the Sinfonia more permanently and we estimate that £5000 is needed. The cut off date for the pledges is 31 August.

There are four different levels of sponsor each involving a different annual payment and receiving a different number of free tickets to the Farnham Sinfonia Concerts. All sponsors will be invited to the TBS Reception held just before the Tilford Bach Festival each June.
